



## PROCEDURE 1.1.6

### AGRICULTURAL DAY PROCEDURE

#### RATIONALE:

The school's Agricultural Day plays an important role in the life of the school community.

#### PURPOSES:

- To provide children with the opportunity to engage in healthy competition on a local and or district basis.
- To promote responsibility and education of caring for animals and plants.
- To provide the opportunity to participate in a range of activities.

#### GUIDELINES:

1. To follow the rules and suggestions outlined in the Guides for Competitors from the Horowhenua Boys and Girls Agricultural Club.
2. New Entrants (5yrs+) must be enrolled and attending school by the commencement of Term Four.
3. Principal and staff with the help of parents to organise Agricultural Day activities.
4. Participating children shall receive recognition of their efforts (certificate, ribbon, rosette and pennant).
5. All children will have the opportunity to participate in a range of activities ie flower work, gardening, animal care, and baking.
6. The Principal will advise parents/caregivers, prior to the day by way of a newsletter, the arrangements for the drop off for animals/competitions etc (baking etc). These arrangements may change from year to year due to the ground conditions etc leading up to the day.
