

INFORMATION FOR AGRICULTURAL DAY:



Bottle Tombola – we will be holding our bottle tombola and ask all families to please send a bottle to school as soon as possible so they can be wrapped and numbered. You can send a bottle of fizzy drink, shampoo, oils, bubble bath, spices or whatever you can think of in a bottle! No alcohol please.

All money from the sale of students work, bottle tombola, etc will go towards the end of year trip

Students will be judged in – Year's 0 – 2, 3 & 4, 5 & 6 and 7 & 8.

Floral Section – students must complete their entries at home if they want to enter, and bring them to school on Friday 15 November for judging.



All students - may have one entry in the following – Floral Arrangement in novelty container eg boot, shoe, tin (can use greens/flowers or dried)



Baking Section – to be judged on Saturday - baking must be delivered to Room 1 between 8.30am and when the **doors close for judging at 9.25am.**



All students - may have one entry in each of the following



3 Pikelets, 3 Iced Biscuits, Un-iced Chocolate Cake and a Decorated Cake

Naming cards will be in Room 1 with the person in charge – these must be placed under the entry (name down).

Children who are having a calf, lamb, kid, garden or domestic pet must have returned their forms by Wednesday 6 November to be eligible to enter this year's competitions
