

TOKOMARU SCHOOL - INFORMATION FOR AGRICULTURAL DAY:



Floral/Baking Section – students must complete their entries at home and bring them to school by 8.55am on **Thursday 12 November** for judging.
All entries will need to be taken home at the end of the day.



Students will be judged in – Year's 0 – 2, 3 & 4, 5 & 6 and 7 & 8.

All students - may have **one entry** in each of the following –

Floral Arrangement in novelty container eg boot, shoe, tin (can use greens/flowers or dried)
Mini Scene – in a shoebox (or similar size box) – no sand to be used

Baking - 3 Decorated Biscuits and/or a Decorated Cake

Year 8's will have a special task and this will be announced shortly.



Students who have a calf, lamb or domestic pet will need to bring their floral/baking entries to school by 8.55am. They can then go back home and will need to bring their pets to school by 1.00pm – judging starts at 1.30pm.



For the calf entries the event number is 12745470 – you will need to create a movement from your NAIT number within 48 hours of the movement.

Domestic Pets – *all pets must be in cages/bowl and you must bring your written information sheets to discuss with the judge.*

Pets are the responsibility of the students and must be looked after at all times, students only will be permitted with their pet during judging.

Farm Pets - *once the pet is on the school grounds only the travel stains can be washed off by parents. If parents continue to groom the animals the pet will be disqualified from all judging.*

Entry numbers will be on a board outside and these must be worn on the top of the right arm and must be returned to the board at the completion of judging.

Pet Dress Up Section – this will take place at the completion of judging and students who enter will be given a school ribbon for taking part.

Levin Group Finals – Friday 20 November – if your child intends to go to Levin they must give their names to Mrs Earle before leaving school on Thursday.

Gardens – will be judged in the week of 23 - 27 November.

Vehicles – animals will need to be unloaded at the bottom of the school driveway and then walked into school - vehicles are to be kept off the school grounds.

School Cups – agricultural, sports and end of year cups – we would like these all returned to school by **Friday 30 October**.
