



## WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP– PUPILS



### PARENTS PLEASE NOTE:

It is a good idea to involve your children in packing gear so they know what they have with them.

Please ensure all clothing is named. This includes small items like socks and undies. Responsibility cannot be taken for lost property that is not named. If any lost property is found at the camp after we depart it will be held at the camp for a short time only.

One large bag for gear is better than several small ones as children are less likely to mislay one bag. Include a large plastic bag with your name on it. All dirty clothes can be put in it. Especially important in wet weather.

### WHAT TO BRING:

All Students are required to provide the following:

- Your own named crockery, cutlery and 1 or 2 tea-towels for personal use
- Sleeping bag, blankets and pillow-case. (Pillows are provided, however for health reasons all campers must provide their own case)
- Clothes, sleepwear and underwear appropriate for a 2 night stay and weather appropriate. As weather and temperature is variable at this time of year, please prepare for both.
- Footwear as well as appropriate footwear for outdoor activities (runners or sports shoes that can get muddy) Gumboots- optional but could be handy
- Old clothes suitable for outdoor activities
- Sun block and school sun hat
- Towel (or 2 as we will be swimming/going on waterslide), facecloth
- Togs for the pool and/or waterslide. Wearing of clothes is prohibited
- Torch
- Plastic bag for any wet/dirty clothing
- Toiletries: Soap, Shampoo, Conditioner, Toothpaste, Tooth Brush, Hair Brush etc
- Sanitary items if required
- Water Bottle
- Raincoat
- Entertainment- suggestions include: book, cards, sudoku, crossword/wordfind book, colouring in book and pens- *no technology*
- Insect Repellent-optional
- Hand Sanitiser

**NONE OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PERMITTED AND MAY RESULT IN THE STUDENT BEING SENT HOME FROM CAMP**

- ☐ **Technology: no games, speakers, radios or phones.** If a student needs to call home in an emergency this can be arranged. Cameras are the **only** technology allowed but we take no responsibility!
- ☐ **Food of any type.** Due to allergies and food safety requirements. This includes any type of confectionery, mint or gum.
- ☐ **Medication:** see health form. These will need to be given to Miss A with clear dosage information. Students may not have it in their bags.
- ☐ **Money:** There will be no opportunity to purchase anything.
- ☐ **Do not bring anything to camp that is valuable and/or likely to be ruined**
