

# Ag Day reminders for participants

## Creative Entries

- Students who are entering a Floral Arrangement, a Mini Scene or Baking need to have all their entries to the library by 8.55am.

## Lambs & Calves

- Arrive from 12:30pm, judging starts at 1pm.
- Suitable protective footwear required.
- All participants will receive a green ribbon, if no place ribbon is awarded (Lambs only).
- There will be a dress up parade for any lambs in costume; a Tokomaru School ribbon will be awarded to all dressed up lambs.
- Entry numbers will be on a board outside and these must be worn on the top of the right arm. These must be returned to the board at the completion of judging.
- Students who have a calf, lamb or domestic pet will need to bring any floral/baking entries to school by 8.55am. They then have the option to go back home and will need to bring their pets to school by 12.30pm – judging starts at 1.00pm.
- Students with calves will need to provide the judge with their TB card.

## Domestic Pets

- Arrive from 12:30pm, judging starts at 1pm.
- Students must stay with their pet and be present during judging.
- All pets must be in a cage or box.
- You must bring your written project to discuss with the judge.

## Gardens

- Flower and vegetable gardens will be judged between the 21<sup>st</sup> - 25th November. The actual judging day it yet to be confirmed.
- Please have your project books at school by Monday 21<sup>st</sup> November ready for judging.

**Note: If you are not coming to school until 12:30pm (with your pet) on Ag Day please let the office know.**

**All lamb and calf entrants have the option to go to Group Final Day.**

**If you intend to go to Group Finals, you will need to enter with Roxanne at the office before 3pm on Ag Day.**
